- 2. The abstract/summary of the thesis must be accompanied by proof of the award of the degree/ University Notification.
- 3. One soft copy of the abstract/ executive summary of the Ph.D. thesis duly typed in double space must be submitted in Times New Roman, Font Size 12, in MS Word by the contestants.
- 4. The Abstract/Summary should contain the topic of the thesis, rationale, objectives, method (study,

- design, sample, and tools), salient findings, and implications of the study.
- 5. To be eligible for the contest, the Ph.D degree of participant has been awarded between January 2019 to January 2024,
- 6. A panel of subject experts will shortlist the abstracts/ summaries of the five best candidates. These shortlisted candidates will be invited to present it before the jury members as per schedule.
- 7. Internal faculty can not participate in contest.

- 2. Kindly send the abstract and full paper in soft copy to the E-mail: conference@pimd.edu.in and a copy (cc) should be sent to conferencesec@pimd.edu.in
- 3. Abstract of a minimum of 150 to 200 words must be typed clearly in Times New Roman font of size 12; mentioning the Title of the Paper, Name, Affiliation and Contact Details of the Author(s) with at least three keywords.
- 4. Full Paper must be submitted in English, with MS Word docx. format, typed clearly in Times New Roman font of size 12; mentioning the Title of the Paper (typed in font of size 14 in upper the lower case leers, bold and flush the le margin) on A4 size paper in 1.5 line-spaced with adequate margins on both sides.

- Use a single-column layout with le and right margins justified. The paper should be well structured with proper indexing. You are required to use your unique ID provided by organizers as your MS Word file name.
- 5. The paper must be accompanied by the author's name (s), affiliation (s), full postal address, email ID, and telephone number along with the title of the paper on the front page. No other page should contain the above said details as the papers will be sent for blind review. Selected full research papers will be published in indexed journals.
- 6. For the presentation of the paper/s at the conference, the contributors are requested to register themselves at an early date. Registration and presentation of the paper by at least one author at the conference are mandatory to ensure the inclusion of the paper in the Journal (if qualify as per guidelines)

#### **BY RAIL**

Dewas Junction is the main railway Station of Dewas city. It is well connected to nearby Stations such as Indore (INDB) and Ujjain via an electrified rail line.





#### BY ROAD

Dewas is well connected to major cities across the state and country, via both National and State level highways. NH-47 and NH-52 connect Dewas to Indore and other cities. MP SH-18 connects Dewas to Bhopal, Ujjain and Ahmedabad.
